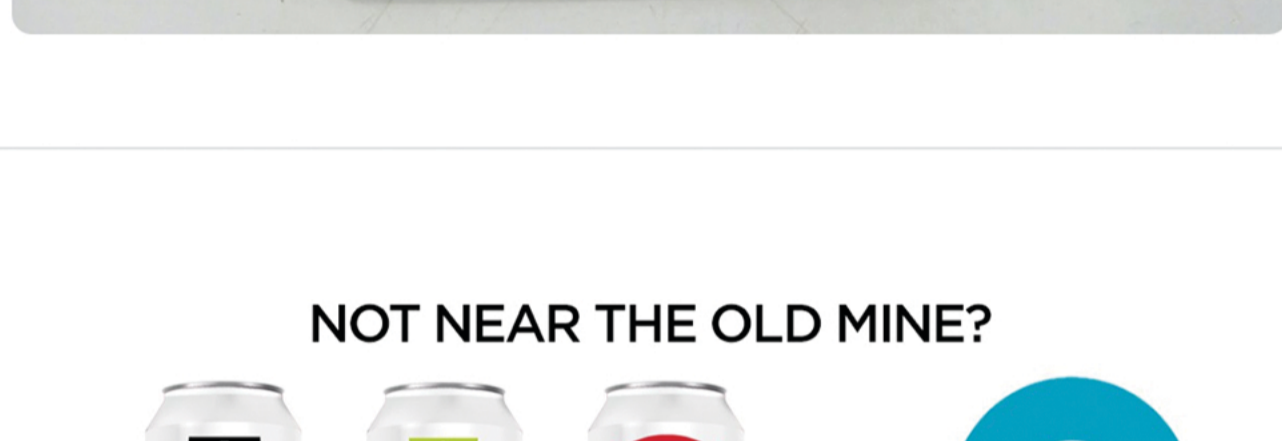
"Only on Wednesdays?!" Kyle shouted.
